- the professional path you pursued after completing the graduate degree including your various positions, companies, key responsibilities, etc.
- professional memberships, community activities, leadership, key skill sets, etc.

To protect your identity, we will remove the masthead (your name and contact information) and any “career objectives” that may identify you as an active job seeker. However, we do wish to keep top skill sets and qualifications within your Career Profile (or Summary of Qualifications) as a teaching tool; please feel welcome to eliminate any “job seeking” statements prior to submitting your resume. In addition, please remove anything else that should not be viewable by our students.

2. **Please answer the following questions:**

- When you were at Krannert, what were your five and ten-year goals? How has “real life” experience or issues you faced changed your perspective on those goals? Please share the impacts including: children, spouse’s job, geography, company downsizing/mergers, economy, work hours, etc.
- Why did you pursue a graduate degree and what coursework has proven most valuable in your professional roles since Krannert? What other courses would have been valuable?
- What advice would you give students currently in the program?
