1. First Time User: Create An Account

2. You will be emailed a temporary PIN to log into the Graduate School Application. (Be sure to check your junk mail folder if you do not see the email.) Log in using your birthdate and this temporary PIN. Once logged in, you will be prompted to create a password. Use this password along with your email address in subsequent logins. Review the [GoldAnswers](#) Web page if you require technical assistance while completing your application. Include *Graduate School Application* in your search.

3. Activate Your Account using your temporary PIN.

4. Begin your applications. Note there is no save button throughout the application. The application will auto save as you move through the fields.

5. Complete your application.
