- All ECON courses CANNOT be taken online, by correspondence or independent study; they must be taken in the classroom.
- ECON minor courses in which you earn an "F" can only be retaken at Purdue University, West Lafayette.
- Space in MGMT/ECON/OBHR courses is not guaranteed.
- Pre-requisite courses appear in parentheses ().
- Only one upper division course may be used for the minor from a Krannert Study Abroad Program.
