- MAI courses, or their equivalents, may only be enrolled in two times for a grade or W.
- A maximum of three MAI courses may be retaken.
- Math courses numbered below your highest level of recorded achievement may not be retaken.
- School of Management, MAI, concentration and minor courses in which you earn an "F" can only be retaken at Purdue University, West Lafayette.
