ACCOUNTING CERTIFICATE ELECTIVES

- Candidates for the Certificate will be undergraduate accounting majors and will complete at least 150 credit hours, consisting of the coursework that makes up the undergraduate accounting major and the additional 27 credit hours detailed below.
- Candidates will take **four 3-credit accounting electives**. Candidates must earn a C or better in each accounting course that they wish to count towards the Certificate.
- Candidates for the Certificate will take **5 classes from the following List A and B, with a minimum of 2 classes from each list**. Pre-requisites are in parentheses; a course number that is followed by a c is a co-requisite. A course number that is followed by a * is one for which grade of C or better is required to satisfy the pre-requisite.

- Notes:
1. Students may enroll for three accounting electives in any semester by: (a) taking an additional course, (b) by accelerating a List A or List B elective to an earlier semester, or (c) by deferring a List A or List B elective to a later semester.
 2. Courses used to complete the 124 credit hour accounting major cannot be used to fulfill the Certificate requirements. 27 credit hours of courses from this sheet must be taken in addition to all major requirements. Courses from List A or B can be taken prior to the 5th year but may only be counted for the Certificate if not counted for the 124 hour major.
 3. Students who take an 4th year spring internship and who want to graduate at the end of the 5th year summer session must plan ahead so that the courses they need to take to complete requirements of both the 124 credit hour Accounting plan of study and the 150 credit hour certificate plan of study will be available in the 5th year summer session.
