Economics Admissions Index (EAI)

- To be admitted to Upper Division Economics, students must complete all EAI courses with an EAI GPA of 2.75 or higher, must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher, must have a C- or higher in all EAI and ECON courses, and must not be on academic probation.
- Previous enrollments in MA 16100 / MA 16500 do not count in the EAI GPA if replaced with MA 16010.
- Previous enrollments in MA 16200 / MA 16600 do not count in the EAI GPA if replaced with MA 16020.
- A maximum of three EAI courses may be retaken one time each for a grade.
- EAI and School of Management (Economics) Foundations courses with grades of "F" may only be retaken at Purdue University.
